Fig. 1.—Group of Living COMATULÆ: *nat.* (Dr. Thompson.)

1a.—A Single COMATULA of the same group, magnified.

2.—PENTREMITES PYRIFORMIS. Ohio.

3, 4.—Surfaces of two pentepetalous joints or ossicula.

5.—One of the bones of APIOCRINITES. Chalk.

6.—ENCRINUS LILIIFORMIS; the body and part of the column attached.  $\frac{1}{3}$  *nat.* From Brunswick.

7.—PENTACRINITAL stem of four angles.

8.—ENTROCHITE, composed of five smooth ossicula.

9.—Quadrangular stem of seven ossicula.

10.—CYATHOCRINITES TUBERCULATUS. (*Murch. Sil. Syst.*)

11.—Receptacle of APIOCRINITES; from the Chalk. Lewes.
