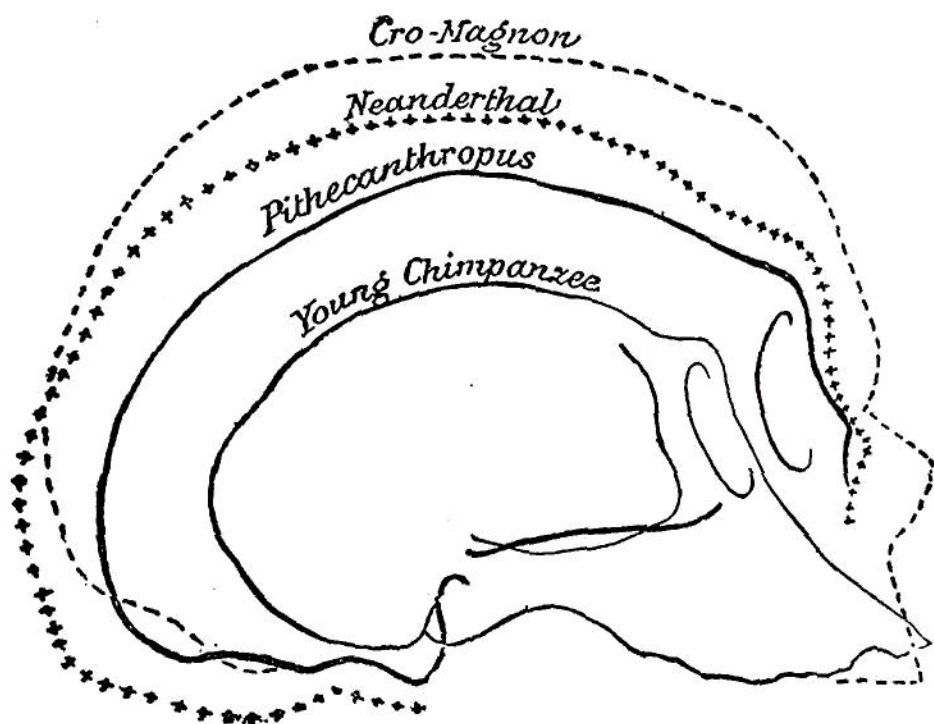
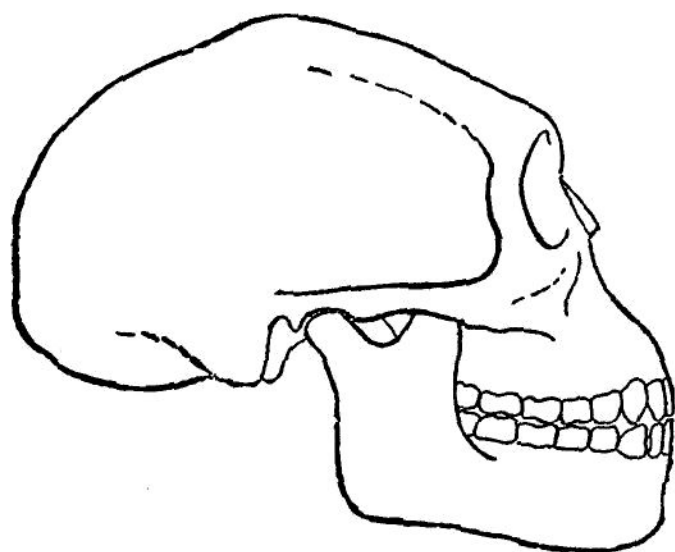




The upper figure represents the outlines of the skull of Pithecanthropus, as restored by Manouvrier.* The lower figure shows the comparative size and shape of Pithecanthropus, the Neanderthal skull a specimen of the Cro-Magnon race of neolithic France, and a Young Chimpanzee before the full development of the supraorbital crests, also after Manouvrier.
