

Quadrupana. *Etym.* quatuor, four; manus, hand. Monkeys, makis or lemurs (*Etym.* lemures, ghosts). The loris tardigradus (tardus, slow; gradior, to walk) is a species of lemur.

Cheiroptera. *Etym.* χειρ, cheir, the hand; πτερον, pteron, a wing. The Bats.

Insectivora. *Etym.* insecta, insects; voro, to eat. Hedgehog; shrew; mole.

Plantigrade. *Etym.* planta, the sole of the foot; gradior, to walk. Bear; racoon.

Digitigrade. *Etym.* digitus, the toe, or finger; gradior, to walk. Lion; wolf; dog; weasel.

Amphibia. *Etym.* αμφι, amphi, both; βιος, bios, life. Walrus; seal.

Marsupialia. *Etym.* marsupium, a pouch. Kangaroo; opossum.

Rodentia. *Etym.* rodo, to gnaw. Squirrel; beaver; rat; hare.

Edentata. *Etym.* edentulus, toothless: animals without the front teeth. Ai; unau; armadillo; ant-eater; tamandua; megatherium ($\mu\varepsilon\gamma\alpha\varsigma$, *megas*, great; θεριον, *therion*, a wild beast;) megalonyx ($\mu\varepsilon\gamma\alpha\varsigma$, *megas*, great; ονυξ, *onyx*, a claw); ornithorhynchus ($\omega\rho\nu\theta\oslash\varsigma$, *ornithos*, of a bird; $\rho\nu\rchi\oslash\varsigma$, *rhynchos*, a beak.)

Pachydermata. *Etym.* παχυς, *pachys*, thick; δερμα, *derma*, skin. Rhinoceros; elephant; mammoth; mastodon ($\mu\alpha\sigma\tau\oslash\varsigma$, *mastos*, a nipple; οδων, *odon*, a tooth); Anoplotherium ($\alpha\nu\omega\pi\lambda\oslash\varsigma$, *anoplos*, unarmed: θηριον, *therion*, wild animal); Palæotherium ($\pi\alpha\lambda\alpha\iota\oslash\varsigma$, *palaios*, ancient: θηριον); tapir; solidungula, as the horse; couagga.

Ruminantia. *Etym.* ruminatio, chewing the cud. Camel; giraffe; deer; goat; cow; sheep.

Cetacea. *Etym.* cetus, a whale. Dolphin; whale; dugong.

SECOND CLASS. *Aves, or Birds.*

Accipitres. *Etym.* accipiter, a hawk. Vulture; eagle; owl.

Passeres. *Etym.* passer, a sparrow. Lark; thrush; swallow; crow; wren.
